LUNCH AND LEARN: JOURNEYING WITH OTHER CHRISTIANS

On Sunday, **Sept. 17th**, Catherine E. Clifford, a Professor of Theology at Saint Paul University, will present a workshop that will explore the basic principles of Catholic ecumenical commitment, relations with diverse Christian denominations, points of progress and continuing disagreement. Pope Francis has invited Catholics to intensify efforts to “walk together” with other Christians, to give common witness to the love of Christ in the world as we grow together in unity. This workshop will be a
