## OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

Let's pack a shoebox and with the help of Operation Christmas Child and their international networks, we can make sure that the shoeboxes get to children in the poorest parts of the world.

Canadian Martyrs youth have been packing boxes for close to a decade now, making sure that children in need receive toiletries, school supplies, basic clothing items and a toy or two, all packed into a shoe box. The two most important items in the shoebox are, however, the Christmas card that each child writes to the child who will receive the box, and the prayer for safety and peace that our children also "place carefully" within the parcel.

Operation Christmas Child is an initiative of Samaritan's Purse International Relief Organization. Through their volunteers from Canada, the US and other countries around the world, they are able to make sure that the millions of shoeboxes gathered actually get to children in need in some of the poorest and most disadvantaged regions.

We have decals on the window at the back of the church to guide purchases for the shoebox, and we ask that these items be brought back to the church on the weekends of **Nov. 4-5** and **11-12**. The youth and I will "stuff" the shoeboxes on Friday, **Nov. 17** and I will deliver them to the local collection centre on Saturday, **Nov. 18**. I am looking forward to reporting back to you how many shoeboxes we are able to pack with your generosity.
