### NEWS FROM JPIC OFFICE

This week JPIC brings a news report from National Geographic on plastic pollution. The article brought a report from Britain, Foresight Future of the Sea, that found plastic pollution in the ocean could triple by 2050 unless a "major response" is mounted to prevent plastic from reaching the ocean. The report declared plastic pollution to be one of the main environmental threats to the seas, along with sea-level rise and warming oceans. This news comes as a wakeup call to the current strategies in decreasing plastic pollution.
