# NATURAL GAS USAGE AND CHARGES

This past heating year (from June 2017 to May 2018 bills) saw a 9% increase in the total natural gas usage by our Parish, while temperatures were 8% colder in terms of heating-degree-days according to Environment Canada. The average gas rates have increased by 1.4% over last year, which when combined with our increase in usage,

led to an 11% increase in natural gas charges for the Parish Centre and Church buildings in 2017-18.
