4.1 Sandwich Club

There have been some problems over the last year with grocery lists being inaccurate and therefore items are purchased that are not needed, which drives the cost of the program up, driving/walking conditions being dangerous in the winter months. To be considered: Lorenzo will deliver all the ingredients to the parish centre, and we will offer either pick up of ingredients at the parish on Thursdays or in-person sandwich making on Thursdays at either 1:30pm or 7pm. Ingredients would still be delivered to the volunteers at Villagia and Immaculata would continue to pick up their ingredients on Thursdays from the parish centre. Action item: Grace will speak with Adele.

4.2 Big Give 2023 Planning

The Big Give happens on the first weekend in June (June 1 in 2024). The parish could plan to have a giveaway yard sale, musicians in the church, baking table etc. Action item: Cheryl and Grace offered to help plan this event.

4.3 Parish Anniversary

The first Mass at the church building was on December 24, 1953. This would be the 70th anniversary of that Mass. PPC will look at doing something to commemorate this anniversary. Action item: Anthony will work on this event with Heather's help.

4.4 2023-2024 PPC Calendar

4.5 Synodality Update – Sue-Anne

The Synod committee had a meeting in late August.
